# Why sloped blocks need special planning

Sloped or uneven land presents several common issues:

- Water runoff and drainage problems
- Limited flat space for entertaining or relaxation
- Erosion and soil movement
- Safety concerns with stairs or access pathways

Instead of working against the slope, embrace it – using levels, terracing and retaining walls to create usable, beautiful zones.



## Use Retaining Walls to create levels

One of the most effective solutions is to break up a sloped yard into tiered levels using retaining walls. This creates flat platforms for:

- Patios
- Gardens
- Pools areas
- Play spaces or seating spaces

Freestone blocks and Coloured Easy Lock blocks are ideal for these types of projects. Not only are they engineered for strength and longevity but their modern face textures complement both traditional and contemporary homes.

#### Design Tip:

Use staggered retaining walls with integrated steps to improve both function and flow between levels therefore choose a retaining wall block with matching caps that you can use for your step treads.




### **Steps and Pathways**

Steep areas often need carefully placed steps or walkways to provide safe and practical access. Use pavers or large stepping stones to build these into the landscape.

For step stones, our Garden Slate Pavers with their slate textured finish and natural look provide a slip resistant walking surface and will complement its environment. For a more modern aesthetic, choose concrete pavers in charcoal or sandstone tones like our Sandstone Steppers or our Master Paver or Beach Sand pavers in shotblast finish.

#### Key Considerations for your steps and paths:

- Ensure step heights are consistent (approximately 160mm rise)
- Choose a textured non-slip paver or handrails for safety
- Incorporate lighting for visability at night





### Prioritise drainage on sloped blocks

Poor drainage is a common issue on sloping sites. Without proper planning, you risk:

- Paver movement or lifting
- Erosion under paths or patios
- Water pooling at the base of retaining walls

Here's how to prevent it:

- Use permeable pavers to allow water to soak through
- Install ag-drains behind retaining walls
- Grade paved areas slightly to direct runoff away from the home.

### Highlight features with terracing

Don't just solve problems – make them beautiful. Sloped blocks allow for multi-dimensional landscaping that can't be achieved on flat ground.

Terraced levels can include:

- A firepit space on its own level
- A dining space using Travertine natural stone for a luxurious and elegant look
- A retained garden or garden beds and grow fruit trees or vegetables.

Using contrasting paver styles, borders or textures between levels to add visual interest.
